The Principles and Practice of Engineering (PE) exam tests for a minimum level of competency in a particular engineering discipline. It is designed for engineers who have gained a minimum of four years' post-college work experience in their chosen engineering discipline. NCEES PE exam information

To become licensed, engineers must complete a four-year college degree, work under a Professional Engineer for at least four years, pass two intensive competency exams and earn a license from their state's licensure board. Then, to retain their licenses, PEs must continually maintain and improve their skills throughout their careers.

What is a PE?

The Principles and Practice of Engineering Exam (PE Exam) is administered by NCEES (National Council of Examiners for Engineering and Surveying), a national organization tasked with regulating the testing of engineers and surveyors. The PE exam is a standardized test administered nationally. The state boards determine PE exam eligibility requirements and, as you can imagine, they vary among ...
